## **NAHFH GOLF CLASSIC RAISES \$125,000 TO BUILD HOMES FOR FAMILIES IN NEED**

**NASHVILLE, Tenn.** (September 18, 2007) – Nashville Area Habitat for Humanity (NAHFH) hosted 28 foursomes in the agency's third annual Golf Classic, presented by Regions on September 10, raising more than \$300,000 (gross) toward the launch of NAFH's next all-Habitat model affordable housing community, Timberwood. The Golf Classic took place at the Golf Club of Tennessee in Kingston Springs.

"This was an exceptional turn-out, and the Golf Club of Tennessee helped make this a great event," said NAFH president and CEO Chris McCarthy. **About Nashville Area Habitat for Humanity**

NAHFH is a non-profit, ecumenical Christian organization committed to providing families with the life changing opportunity to purchase decent, affordable homes. The agency consistently ranks in the top one percent of all Habitat affiliates and has grown by seven times in size since 2002. NAFH will build a record 55 homes in 2007 - 40 locally and 15 abroad. As of July 2007, 1106 family members, including 729 children have been served by NAFH. Prior to becoming homeowners, Habitat partner families must complete up to 475 hours of "sweat equity" at the build site and in the classroom to earn their homes. Mortgage payments at zero percent interest range between \$350 and \$450 per month, including taxes and insurance. NAFH builds ENERGY STAR Certified energy efficient homes.
