Habitat for Humanity of Greater Nashville (“Habitat”) is committed to respecting the privacy of its financial and in-kind donors, whether the donation is made online, by mail, or any other method, as well as volunteers and other supporters. When you make a financial or in-kind donation, you provide your name and contact information. Financial donors provide standard payment information including, in many circumstances, credit card data. We use industry standard safeguards to protect your information. To protect the security of credit card transactions, we utilize measures such as captchas, encryption, access controls, network firewalls, and physical security. Habitat does not sell, share or trade our donors’ personally identifiable information with any other entity. Such data may be provided by Habitat to approved vendors engaged by us to conduct specific Habitat business such as managing donations and donor data and communicating electronically with Habitat donors and volunteers about Habitat’s ministry. These vendors are bound by strict confidentiality rules and are permitted to use data provided by Habitat only to support agency operations as specifically directed by Habitat.
